Connectivity

Today, Bariloche is the Argentine destination with the greatest number of frequencies and airlines. The city is connected both nationally and internationally and receives regular flights from Buenos Aires, Rosario, Córdoba, Mendoza and El Calafate. This facilitates the arrival of visitors from all over the country, additionally providing flexibility at the time of choosing dates and a wide variety of rates as well.

In winter, there are a large number of direct flights coming from Brazil. Furthermore, modern buses from different cities in Argentina and neighboring countries arrive at the bus terminal, making Bariloche a key passenger distribution point for the lake region and Chile.





National Park

Bariloche is located within the Nahuel Huapi National Park, whose goal is the preservation of the Andean forests, the steppe and biodiversity, promoting a greater knowledge of these environments and generating other forms of harmonious integration with life in nature and human development.

Chosen as one of the 7 natural wonders in Argentina, this is the oldest national park in the country (founded on April 8th, 1922), covering an area of 710,000 hectares.

Therefore, Bariloche is an ideal destination to commune with nature, to appreciate the care for the environment and to take social responsibility actions within the framework of an event.

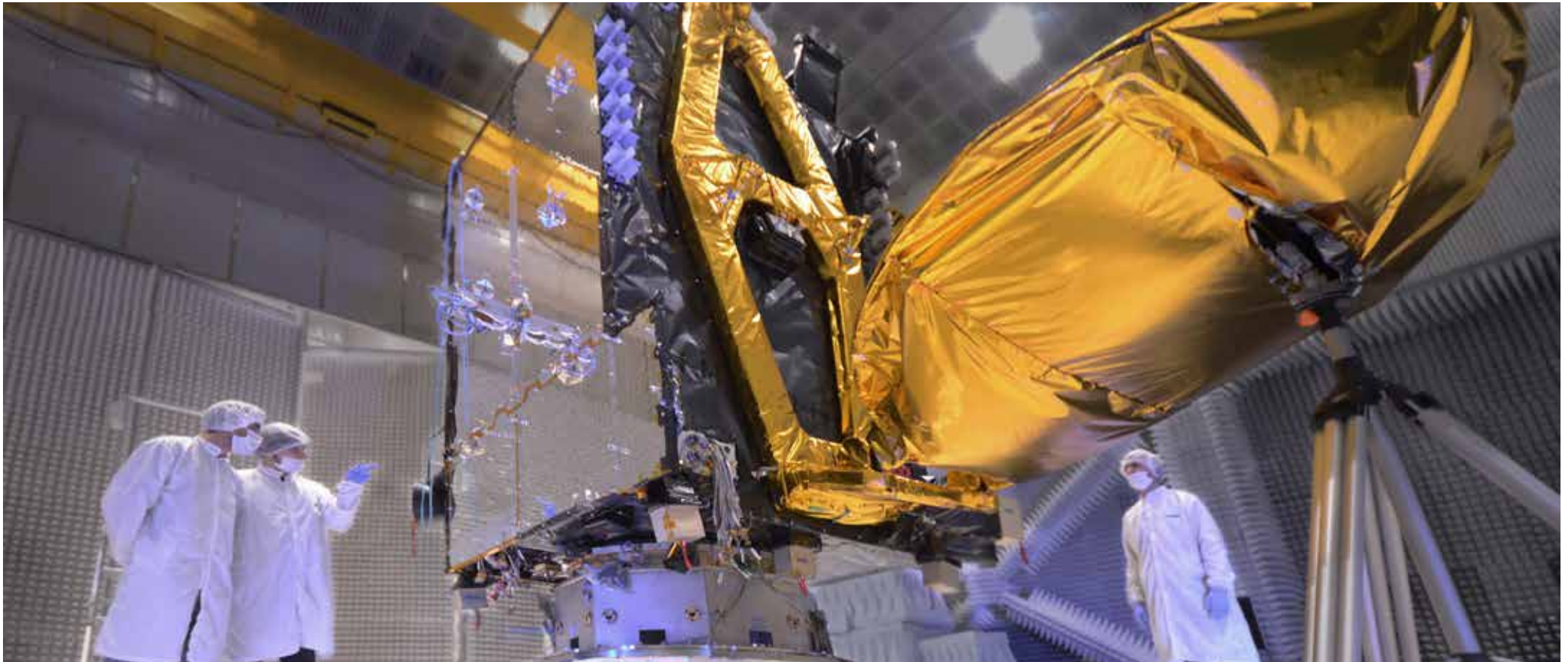

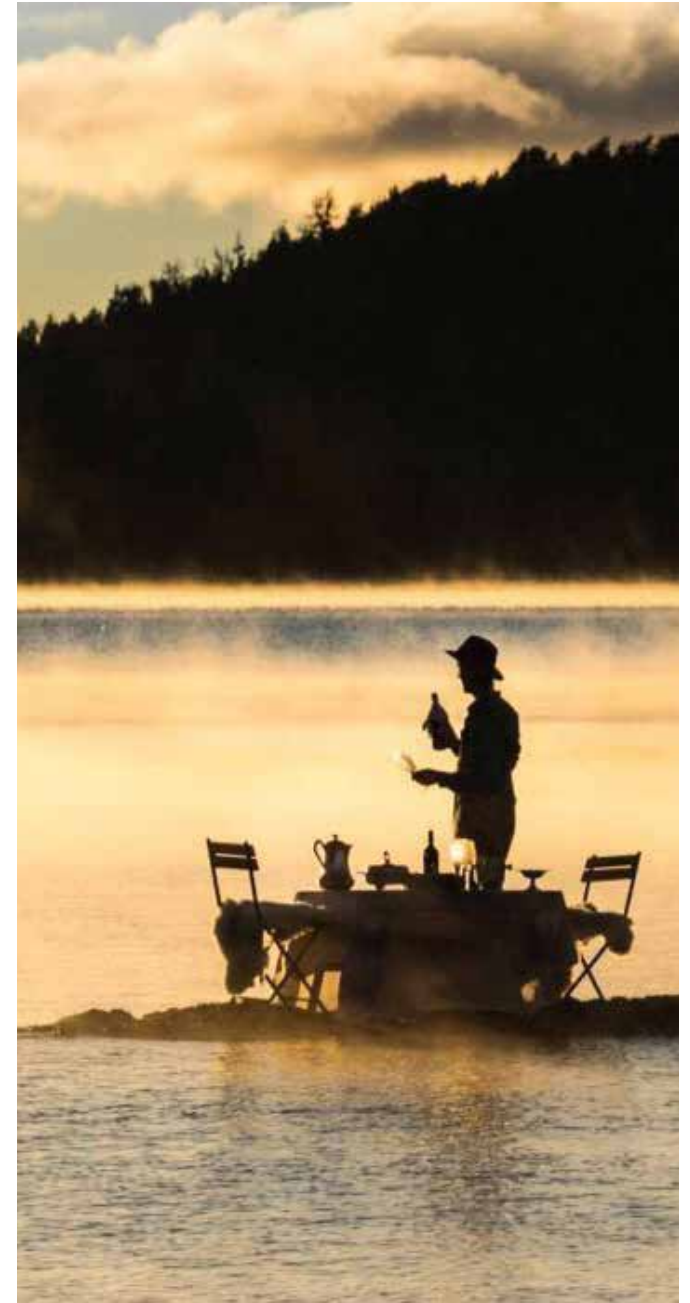
OUTDOOR EVENTS

Bariloche Cathedral

Bariloche Cathedral is called *Nuestra Señora del Nahuel Huapi* and it is the main Catholic temple in the city. It was built in 1944, and it was made with a project that was offered free of charge by the architect Alejandro Bustillo. The building is shaped as a Latin cross and the material used to build it was "white stone". Its head is oriented exactly east, so that the sun illuminates it since dawn. In this way, it is also possible to blur the various variations of light that pass through the stained glass windows. In these stained glasses, that represent images related to the region, we can see Our Lady of Nahuel Huapi, the Jesuit priest Nicolás Mascardi and Ceferino Namuncura, among others. It is a usual venue for music and choral concerts. In May 2019, the Cathedral was a privileged hostess of the FIMBA International Music Festival.

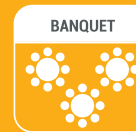


Llao Llao

The mythical *Llao Llao Hotel*, is located in a dream setting 25 km away from Bariloche center. The construction of the hotel was commissioned by the then president of the National Parks Association, Exequiel Bustillo, and executed by his brother, Alejandro Bustillo. The majestic hotel was opened in January 1938 but in October of that year a terrible fire destroyed it. They quickly decided to rebuild it and in 1940, like the phoenix rising from its ashes, the Llao Llao reopened to receive the European aristocracy that was moving away from a continent at war. In 1997, the hotel was acquired by its present owners that started a new phase of remodeling and improvements; the main expression being the construction of the Moreno Wing, 43 modern suites with a Patagonian imprint with a privileged view of Moreno Lake. At present, the hotel has 205

rooms, with a capacity to accommodate 400 people, 6 amazing meeting rooms that can adapt to the needs of each event, a golf course, 18 holes, spa, first class gastronomy and much more. Nature meets history in one place, generating an unmatched venue for any event.

Patagonia Brewery

Microbrewery Patagonia is located at 24.7 km of Circuito Chico. The brewery is designed to enjoy the different varieties of craft beer made with local hops, as well as the best Patagonian food. It has one of the most beautiful views in the city, the Moreno and Nahuel Huapi lakes, and being surrounded by a dream natural landscape, this location is ideal for any event.



By PASS

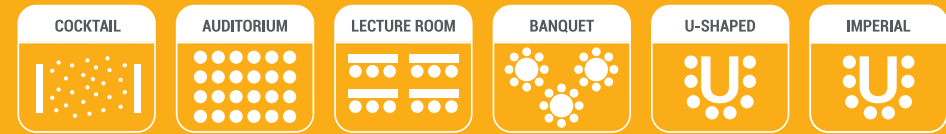
It is one of the *great symbols of Bariloche*; it opened in 1983 and quickly became the most chosen night club by the young public. Most of the students that have chosen Bariloche as their high school graduation trip destination have been at By Pass, generating an emotional bond between By Pass and many potential attendees to events. With a 2,000 people capacity in disco and up to 700 people in cocktail, Bypass is a unique venue in Argentina. Renowned not only for its constant innovation in terms of lighting and sound but also for being the first night club that has received a ISO 9001 quality certification, an occupational health and safety OSHAS 18001 and a ISO 14001 for environmental management. By Pass offers BEC's gastronomy (Bariloche Events & Conventions), and is an unequalled place for congress opening or closing cocktails, camaraderie parties, product launchings and incentive trips.



Modesta Victoria

A *historic vessel* that has become a legend, where famous people have traveled, such as Che Guevara and his friend Alberto Granado when crossing to Chile, The Shah of Persia, Reza Pahlavi, and several former USA presidents such as Eisenhower, Bill Clinton and Barack Obama. As if it were part of the setting of an Agatha Christie's novel, with its bearing from another time and another age, every morning the Modesta Victoria sails the Nahuel Huapi lake. Its history begins when, at the request of the National Parks Administration, it was built in 1937 at the Verchuren Shipyard in Amsterdam (The Netherlands). Bringing it to Bariloche was also an adventure; it was a long trip first by ship and then by train. It arrived to the Argentine Patagonia, in the southern end of South America, totally disassembled. After assembling it, it was launched on November 10th, 1938. It measures 39 meters in length, has three teak decks, bronze fittings and alabaster lampshades and it has a capacity for 300 passengers. It is undoubtedly an incomparable floating location for events and meetings.

UNIQUE VENUES



Barrancos de Huillines - Puerto Blest

Puerto Blest is immersed in the dense vegetation of the Valdivian Forest, surrounded by the impressive Andes Mountains, the Tronador Mountain, the Tres Hermanos Mountain and the Frías Lake, of a peculiar emerald green color, given by the mineral particles of the glacier that feeds it. It is located at 25 km of Puerto Pañuelo, in the city of San Carlos de Bariloche. The only way to access it is either by sailing the Nahuel Huapi lake or by crossing from Chile, the neighboring country, through the Perez Rosales crossing. The peculiar location and the jungle environment that surrounds it make Puerto Blest a unique place where nature, history and modernity converge and complement each other to give its visitors an unforgettable experience. It is an ideal place for travelers looking for relax, connection with nature and to get away from routine and, also for people who would like to do trekking activities in trails immersed in an ecosystem that can only be found in this place in Argentina.



El Casco Art Deco

During the decade of the 70's and for 20 years *El Casco* was a famous lakeside inn that attracted tourists from all over the world with its atmosphere of European glamour and the friendliness of its owners and hosts, Alfred and Ruth von Ellrichshausen. The hotel then passed through the hands of several owners and was closed for seven years until Ignacio Gutiérrez Zaldívar acquired the property.

The new building was built on a classic yet contemporary premise, preserving the spirit that its former owners imprinted on it; it has the same spirit of hospitality and attention to details of the old Casco. It has over 400 masterpieces by the best Argentine artists, both in the common areas and in the spacious rooms, with spectacular panoramic views. The Zurbarán Collection comprises original paintings and sculptures made by 40 great Argentine artists, such as Pablo Curatella Manes, Fernando Fader, Benito Quinquela Martín, Cesáreo Bernaldo de Quirós and Raúl Soldi.
